2015 Cote de L'Ange Châteauneuf-du-Pape

An estate that doesn't get the credit it deserves, the 2015 Châteauneuf-du-Pape (70% Grenache and 15% each of Syrah and Mourvèdre) spots a medium ruby color to go with finesse-driven notes of ripe raspberries, garrigue, peppery herbs, and spice. With medium-bodied richness, sweet tannin and an endearing, balanced style, drink it over the coming decade. This cuvée is brought up in a mix of foudre and concrete tanks.

2015 Cote de L'Ange Châteauneuf-du-Pape Vieilles Vignes

Possessing more richness and depth, the 2015 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Vieilles Vignes (80% Grenache and 20% Mourvèdre) offers terrific notes of black cherries, raspberries, green herbs, thyme, and mint. Impeccably balanced, elegant and silky, with the more mid-weight style of the vintage, it offers plenty of sweet tannins and a great finish. This is a classic, old-school style beauty to enjoy anytime over the coming decade.

2015 Cote de L'Ange Châteauneuf-du-Pape Secret de L'Ange

The 2015 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Secret de L'Ange is the Mourvèdre dominated special cuvée of the estate and checks in as a blend of 80% Mourvèdre and 20% Grenache, which is a blend I'm starting to see more and more. Its deeper ruby color is followed by classic Mourvèdre notes of ripe black cherries, dried spices, earth, and underbrush. Medium to full-bodied, straight up seamless and elegant, with polished tannin, it's a terrific, beautiful wine to enjoy over the coming decade or more.
