2015	<u>Domaine de la Côte de l'Ange</u>	<u>Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc</u>	Limpid yellow. Fresh pear, lemon pith, honeysuckle and dusty minerals on the perfumed nose. Chewy and focused on the palate, offering energetic citrus and orchard fruit flavors that deepen slowly and pick up a hint of tarragon with aeration. Closes on a spicy note, displaying strong lift, an exotic touch of pineapple and lingering florality.	90
2015	<u>Domaine de la Côte de l'Ange</u>	<u>Châteauneuf-du-Pape Secret de l'Ange</u>	Bright violet. Powerful aromas of cherry liqueur, cassis, licorice and woodsmoke carry a sexy floral topnote. Fleshy and sweet on the palate, offering densely packed dark berry compote and violet pastille flavors lifted by a peppery accent. Shows real power and spicy lift on the clinging, youthfully tannic, persistent finish, which features resonating cassis and floral notes.	(91-93)
2015	<u>Domaine de la Côte de l'Ange</u>	<u>Châteauneuf-du-Pape Vieilles Vignes</u>	Lurid ruby. Pungent scents of ripe raspberry, candied flowers and star anise, accompanied by a smoky mineral overtone. Sweet red fruit flavors show good concentration, while suggestions of rhubarb and blood orange give the wine a refreshingly bitter character. Nervy and focused on the finish, which is shaped by dusty, building tannins.	(89-91)
2015	<u>Domaine de la Côte de l'Ange</u>	<u>Châteauneuf-du-Pape</u>	Dark ruby. Deep-pitched dark berry, licorice and floral aromas, backed by peppery spice and game nuances. Sappy and focused on the palate, offering bitter cherry and cassis flavors given backbone and lift by juicy acidity. A smoky nuance comes up on the dark-fruit-driven finish, and chewy tannins provide shape and closing grip.	(88-90)
