# Châteauneuf-du-Pape Vieilles Vignes 2012 93 points / \$73/ 400 cases made / Red

Very dark in profile, with baker's chocolate, tar and licorice root notes embedded in a fleshy core of braised fig and warm black-berry confiture. Lots of bay leaf and pepper accents line the finish, giving this a decidedly old-school feel. Best from 2015 through 2026. 400 cases made. –JM

## Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2012 91 points / \$44/ 1200 cases made / Red

A dark, slightly brawny style, with fig and plum fruit studded with licorice root, Turkish coffee and tar notes. Sage, bay leaf and lavender details line the fleshy finish. Drink now through 2022. 1,200 cases made. –JM
