## 2016 Domaine de La Cote de L'Ange Châteauneuf-du-Pape

The 2016 Châteauneuf-du-Pape sports a deep, inky color as well as an incredibly young, unevolved style in its black and blue fruits, new leather, pepper, and damp earth-like aromas and flavors. Deep, full-bodied, tannic, and powerful, it's slightly hard to read given its almost primordial feel, yet it has a stacked mid-palate, good acidity, and ample length. Give bottles 2-4 years, and it should shine for 15+. Tried twice.

Domaine de La Côte de L'Ange produces a ripe yet traditional style of wine. In addition to their Châteauneuf-du-Papes, they make a terrific Côtes du Rhône as well.
