The 2018 Châteauneuf Du Pape is a beauty, offering a plush, upfront, sexy style as well as notes of black raspberries, kirsch, ground pepper, and garrigue. Based on 65% Grenache, 25% Mourvèdre, and the rest Syrah, it's medium to full-bodied, with good mid-palate depth and sweet tannins.

This estate continues to produce a classic, traditional style of Châteauneuf du Pape that has loads to love. In addition, readers shouldn't overlook their white (and their Côtes du Rhône)!
