Reductive and bloody on the nose. Lively with freshness, edge and cut. This is great – real intensity and vibrancy, no overripeness or heaviness and a really mineral, chalky edge. Some length too. All nicely directional and tucked in. Fermented and aged in concrete and large oak tanks.
