2024 Domaine De La Cote De L'Ange Chateauneuf Du Pape

Coming from the galets roulés and limestone terroirs of Coteau de l'Ange, les Marines, Moulin à Vent, la Nerthe, and les Terres Blanches, the 2024 Châteauneuf Du Pape is based on 65% Grenache, 25% Mourvèdre, and 10% Syrah, destemmed and vinified in concrete vats, then aged in 50% concrete and 50% truncated concrete vessels. Deep ruby/purple-hued, it offers textbook notes of peppery black fruits, licorice, roasted meats, and violets. It brings medium-bodied richness, a layered, seamless mouthfeel, and ripe, velvety tannins. There are roughly 2,083 cases of this impeccably made wine, which is well worth seeking out. Drink 2025-2035.

I continue to love the wines from Domaine de la Côte de l'Ange. These are always classic, soulful, satisfying wines that are impeccably made.
